Anti-social behaviour (ASB) is social harm directed against individuals, communities or the environment. It is any activity that impacts on other people in a negative way. Selfish and unacceptable activities can blight the quality of community life and we are committed to tackling them.

Examples of ASB include:

- Nuisance neighbours
- Intimidating groups taking over public spaces
- Vandalism, graffiti and fly-posting
- People dealing and buying drugs on the street
- People dumping rubbish and abandoning cars
- Begging and anti-social drinking
- The misuse of fireworks
- The misuse of mini-motos

To be effective in tackling ASB we need your support. We need information about where, when and who is involved in these incidents. This will allow your local neighbourhood officers, in partnership with Birmingham City Council, to address the incidents of ASB appropriately.
